

3. Article XIII, Clothing, Section 2 shall be amended by striking out "\$175.00" and substituting therefore two hundred fifteen dollars (\$215.00).

4. Article XX, Terminal Leave, shall be amended to provide that the members in the bargaining unit represented by the Association shall have the terminal leave pay, required therein to be paid to a member upon retirement, in a separate check, at the option of the member, provided that notice of desire to exercise such option be given the Town together with the filing of the member's retirement papers with it.


5. The agreement between the parties shall be effective for a period of one (1) year (Article XXX) to midnight December 31, 1978, and shall be effective retroactive to and including January 1, 1978.

6. All other provisions of the previous contract between the parties shall be continued in full force and effect for the term of the new contract.

7. The parties hereto are directed to enter into a new agreement which shall embody these terms.

This award, not objected to by either party, conforms to and has taken into account all relevant factors, including those matters set forth in Section 209.4 of the Civil Service






